A guide to OPSEC

WHAT IS OPSEC?

Operational Security is a risk management process that helps leaders to see operations from the perspective of an adversary in order to protect sensitive information from falling into the wrong hands.

It's important to execute measures that eliminate or reduce vulnerabilities that may lead to adversary exploitation.

DO'S

a Don't give out

- Use different screen names for social media profiles.
- Check the background of your photos for distinct lankmarks/ sensitive info before posting.
- Practice positivity.
- Turn off geotagging and location-based social networking on phones and digital cameras.
- Maximize security settings.

 Don't give out personal information such as phone numbers, residential area or personal/ unit details.

DON'TS

- Don't post photos from your spouse's location.
- Don't share strong political, controversial opinions. This should be kept offline!
- Don't post information protected under the Privacy Act.

IF YOU SEE AN OPSEC RISK

Record information and remove if possible.

Inform the individual of the OPSEC violation.

Notify your spouse of any potential OPSEC violation.

Educate your friends & family about OPSEC, why it's important and what they can do about it if they witness a violation.
