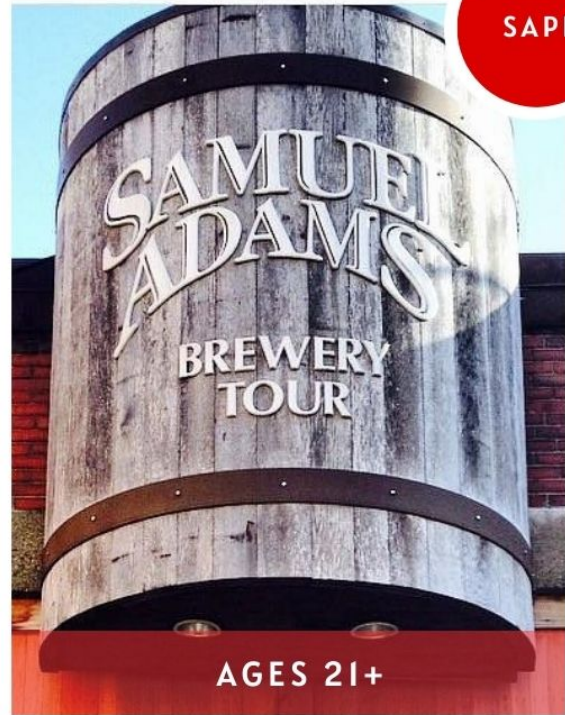
Here's a quick breakdown on which trips **you** can qualify for:
